According to the agreement with Elsevier, member institutions of EISZ consortium have the opportunity to publish open access through ScienceDirect. The agreement applies to all of the publisher's online hybrid and Gold Open Access journals, the copyright is provided by Creative Commons CC-BY and CC-BY-NC-ND licenses. The authors are exempt from the APCs.

Authors can choose from Elsevier's 2000 hybrid and Gold OA journals. Lancet and Cell journals are an exception.

List of eligible journals

Conditions:

- the correspondent author of the article must have an affiliation with the EISZ member institution participating in the consortium,
- Articles which acceptance date for publication falls within the duration of the agreement (01.01.2022 31.12.2022) are eligible for funding under the agreement.
- article type: scientific article,
- the article should be accepted into an eligible journal.

Note: For articles with multiple corresponding authors, the corresponding author is the one who submits the article to the journal and maintains contact during the publication process. An author who is designated as a correspondent but who did not submit the manuscript, does not correspond, and does not complete the license required to appear in OA is not considered a corresponding author for the purposes of this Agreement.

Quota: the entire Hungarian consortium may publish 1,000 articles at the expense of the agreement in 2022.
